SIGHTSEEING: By modern motorcoach including services of English-speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visa fees, laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters and after-dinner coffee or tea, meals not included in the itinerary, room service, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned. TRAVEL INSURANCE (optional), Maranatha Tours Inc. will automatically bill all passengers for travel insurance unless it is declined at the time of reservation or in writing by the participant).

TOUR PRICE: Price is based on international tariffs and rates in effect on date of proposal and is subject to change without notice should there be a revision in AIR or LAND rates prior to departure of tour. Price is based on a minimum of passengers using double occupancy. In the event that a minimum of passengers does not book the tour within 45 days of departure the agent reserves the right to cancel or re-cost the tour. Late booking or changes may result in an additional fee. Maranatha Tours, Inc. reserves the right to correct invoices, itineraries, and/or brochures without notice.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$300 per person is required to secure reservations, which will be applied to the price of the tour. The balance to be paid in full not later than 6 weeks prior to departure of the tour. Thereafter, a \$100 late payment fee will be assessed. Reservations made within 30 days of departure are subject to \$75 late reservation charge. All cancellations must be in writing by letter, fax or e-mail to MaranathaTours and will be in effect on the date of receipt by Maranatha Tours. There is no exception to cancellation fee. Any exceptions must be in writing from Maranatha Tours, Inc.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: A round-trip economy class jet, via International air carrier or any other IATA member. Full payment is due 45 days prior to commencement of travel. If the passenger cancels within 35 days of departure or after air tickets are written (whichever comes sooner), then 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger. In the event 35 passengers do not book the tour within 90 days of departure, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice.

TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 - Saturday, November 27 - PHOENIX / TEL AVIV

Today we will meet at Sky Harbor International airport for our flights to Tel Aviv via wide-body aircraft arriving the next day. Meals served on board.

DAY 2 - Sunday, November 28 - TEL AVIV / JAFFA / NETANYA

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv we are met by our guide who will be with us for the time we are in the Holy Land. Board our bus and travel through Tel Aviv, the largest city in Israel. Our stop will be at Jaffa (Joppa), the city of Jonah, where Peter had his housetop experience at the home of Simon the Tanner. We proceed to the city of Netanya, on the Mediterranean to our hotel where we will check in overnight.

DAY 3 - Monday, November 29 - NETANYA / CAESAREA / MEGIDDO / TIBERIAS

This morning we proceed to Caesarea, capital of the Roman procurators of Judea. Visit the Roman port, Crusader's Moat, Roman theater and aqueduct. Continue to Muhraqa on Mount Carmel where Elijah challenged Baal's priests. This afternoon, after a Middle Eastern lunch at a Druse restaurant, we proceed to Megiddo to visit the excavations that unearthed 20 different civilizations. This is Michener's "The Source". Then, it's on to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight at our hotel. On the way, if there is time we will stop at Harod, the spring of Gideon.

DAY 4 - Tuesday, November 30 - TIBERIAS / UPPER GALILEE

This morning we leave Tiberias and head north via Magdala into the valley of Gennesareth to Ginossar to view the New Testament boat found below the sea and to visit the kibbutz. Then on to Chorazin, through the Hula Valley to Hazor, ruins of the powerful Canaanite city destroyed by Joshua and rebuilt by King Jabin and then by Solomon as a chariot city to command upper Galilee. We continue to the northern limits of Jesus' travel as we cross the River Hatzbani to Dan, where we combine a nature walk beside the Upper Jordan with views of the ancient ruins, topped by the Israelite high place that supported a golden calf (I Kings 12). Then a short drive to Banias (Caesarea Philippi), dedicated to Pan the Greek god of pastures, flocks and shepherds; here Peter made his great profession of faith, recognition of Christ Jesus (Matthew 16). Driving along the foot of Mount Hermon, we ascend onto the Golan Plateau for a magnificent view of upper Israel. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 - Wednesday, December 01 - TIBERIAS / SEA OF GALILEE / BET SHEAN / DEAD SEA

This morning we take a relaxing boat ride on the Sea of Galilee where we will be able to look to the shore where so many miracles occurred. We continue to Capernaum and see first century ruins, then visit Tabgha and the Mount of Beatitudes. This afternoon we travel via the Crusader fortress of Belvoir along the Rift Valley to Bet Shean, where King Saul and his sons were pinned to the walls. It became the Decapolis Capital and was traveled by Jesus and known as Scythopolis. See the ancient theater, Circus Maximus and Cardo Maximo. We head down the Jordan River road and enter the Judean wilderness, on our way to the Dead Sea. We will pass by the Dead Sea as we go to our hotel on the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6 - Thursday, December 02 - DEAD SEA / MASADA / JERICHO

This morning we will have some time for a swim in the Dead Sea or a mud bath that cleanses many skin disorders. We then drive to Masada and ascend by cable car to the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70 to 73 AD, Jewish defenders made their last stand in the Judean revolt against Rome. We see the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth-century Byzantine church. Continuing alongside the Dead Sea, 1300 ft. below sea level -- the lowest spot on earth -- we stop at Ein Gedi. Here we will have time for lunch or to walk to the water falls that David would have used while he was fleeing from Saul. This afternoon we proceed to Qumran and the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. We travel to Jericho, the world's oldest city. Then we head up to Jerusalem where we will enter the Golden City for a panoramic view. Continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7 - Friday, December 03 - JERUSALEM / RABBI TUNNEL / TEMPLE INSTITUTE / YAD VASHEM / SHRINE OF THE BOOK

This morning we will board our bus for our exciting tour to the famous Rabbi Tunnel. Here we will enter by the Western wall plaza and go down to the foundation of the Second Temple. Continue along the tunnel as we proceed to the Gateway of the Priests entry to the Holy of Holies. We will continue to the Temple Institute where we will see the making of the instruments for the new temple. We will see how they are following the Bible for exact instructions. We will see a film explaining where the Rabbi believes the Ark of the Covenant is found. This afternoon we will head to Yad Vashem and see the Museum of the Holocaust. Continue to Shrine of the Book and the model city of Jerusalem at the time of the Second Temple. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 - Saturday, December 04 - MT. OF OLIVES / BETHLEHEM

We start the day with an orientation to Jerusalem from the Mt. of Olives. We then walk the traditional Palm Sunday route to the church known as Dominus Flevit ("Our Lord weeps"). After viewing the Golden Gate, we walk downhill to Gethsemane and take time to meditate on the Gospel text. Then we drive to the Dung Gate and walk to the Southern Wall excavations. We then examine the ruins near the south side of the Temple complex, including steps where we may be certain that Jesus and the disciples walked. Then we travel to the slopes of Mt. Zion where we will visit the Upper Room and King David's Tomb. This afternoon we visit Solomon's Pools, Jerusalem's main source of water for almost 2000 years. Passing the monastery of Hortus Conclusus ("the sealed garden") in Artas, we go to Shepherds' Fields. We conclude the day by walking through Bethlehem's alleys and markets to the Church of the Nativity. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 - Sunday, December 05 - OLD CITY / SOUTHERN WALL / UPPER ROOM / GARDEN TOMB

After breakfast we transfer to the Dung Gate and walk up to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest site. We ascend to the Dome of the Rock and the al-Aqsa Mosque, the third holiest site of Islam, located on the traditional site of the ancient Temple Mount. It is believed that here is where the Temple once stood. Just to the north we find the Pools of Bethesda (John 5) and St. Anne's Church, perfectly preserved from the Crusader period. We then follow the Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa) through the bazaars as far as the Holy Sepulcher and walk through the Christian Quarter along the Arab Souks and past the Armenian Quarter. This afternoon, exit the Old City at Mt Zion to the grounds of a church called Peter in Gallicantu, which affords the best view of early Jerusalem from the west. From there we board our bus and transfer to the Garden Tomb where we will end our day with a special visit and the possibility of having a private communion on the grounds outside the city walls.

DAY 10 - Sunday, December 6 - JERUSALEM / LONDON / PHOENIX

This morning we will have some time to have a last visit to the old city or just rest and get ready for our flight to Rome. This afternoon we transfer to the airport for our flight to Rome. Then to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 10 - Monday, December 06, 2010 - JERUSALEM / ROME

This morning we will have some time to have a last visit to the old city or just rest and get ready for our flight to Rome. This afternoon we transfer to the airport for our flight to Rome. Upon arrival we will be taken to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 11 - Tuesday, December 07 - PAUL'S DAY

This morning we will visit the most interesting sites which are linked with the life of the Apostle Paul in Rome. INSULA DI SAN PAOLO ALLA REGOLA: Tradition has it that Paul used to live in this area during the years of his first imprisonment. Here Paul met with the first Christians in Rome. CHURCH OF SANTA PRISCA: Now Prisca came from a rich Roman family and Aquila, her husband was probably Greek. Paul spent a couple of years with them in Corinth and this is very often mentioned in his Letters and the Book of Acts (see Rom 16,1-23, Rom 16, 3-5 and Act 18, 1-3). Visit the church where you can still see the big Doric Capital used by Apostle Peter to baptize Prisca. CATACOMBS OF SAN SEBASTIAN is Located on the Ancient Appian Way, this is the place where the bodies of Apostles Paul and Peter where kept during the Christian persecution of Valeriano (253 – 260 AC). ABBEY OF THE THREE FOUNTAINS is the place of Paul's martyrdom, where tradition has it that three different springs gushed out at each spot touched when Paul's head fell down. ST PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS: St. Paul outside the Walls is a Benedictine Abbey which shares its name, origins and centuries of history, both joyful and sorrowful, with the adjoining Basilica. Visit the Basilica where the bones of Paul have recently been found and you will leave Rome with the real spirit of first Christians in your mind and in your heart. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 12 - Wednesday, December 08 - ROME / TREVİ FOUNTAIN / CATACOMBS

After breakfast, transfer for a full day tour of classical Rome. In the morning there will be sightseeing of the Trevi Fountain, Pantheon and Navona Square; with its beautiful Bernini's Fountain of the Rivers. In the afternoon enjoy a visit to one of the most beautiful Catacombs and a drive along a section of the Old Appian Way where we will see the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving patrician tombs that once lined its way. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight

DAY 13 - Thursday, December 09 - ROME / USA

We transfer to the airport for our flight home with unforgettable memories to cherish always. Knowing we have walked in the footsteps of the early Christians on such a memorable tour will bring new meaning to our Bible reading.
